Role Title	Brathay 262
Where	At strategic points around the course or on site at Brathay Hall.
When	The role involves a one day commitment on Saturday 22 June 2019.
Commitment	One-off. Although we encourage you to get involved in other ways or help again the following year.
Duration	The role length varies dependent upon location and time you're willing to offer. As the event is a 24 hour event volunteers at all times of day are needed. Shifts are organised before the event, any period of time you can offer will be greatly appreciated.

Your Tasks	<p>The role has a dual purpose to keep participants safe and encourage them onward.</p> <p>Volunteers are asked to attend a briefing session at a time to be arranged before the Sportive day. At the briefing each Marshall will be given a wealth of information/training to cover all the skills needed on the day.</p> <p>Be punctual/reliable – the cyclists really will be relying on you. Inform the Co-ordinator of any problems that arise Guiding cyclists and warning public to prevent accidents.</p>
How will I be supported?	You will be in contact with your sector organiser and Control who will be on hand if you have any problem or require medical attention for a cyclist.
