

## VOLUNTEER ROLE DESCRIPTION

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| <b>Role Title</b>  | <b>Brathay 262 Volunteer (18+)</b>  |
| <b>Where</b>   | At strategic points around the course or on site at Brathay Hall.   |
| <b>When</b>  | The role involves a one day commitment on Saturday 22 June 2019.  |
| <b>Commitment</b>  | One-off. Although we encourage you to get involved in other ways or help again the following year.  |
| <b>Duration</b>  | The role length varies dependent upon location and time you're willing to offer. As the event is a 24 hour event volunteers at all times of day are needed. Shifts are organised before the event, any period of time you can offer will be greatly appreciated.  |
