B5286 Temporary Full Closure of both lanes
 07.30 – 11.00am
 Start: Junction A593 at Clappersgate
 To: Junction with B5285 at Hawkshead Hall

B5285 OPEN with traffic controls.
 Control at Hawkshead Hall junction of B5285/B5286
 Control at junction leading into main parking areas southern end of Hawkshead

C5026 (Road to Newby Bridge from Bowling Green) Convoy system in operation. Approximately 08.00 – 13.00 between the Bowling Green junction & the Roger Ground junction

C5026 Temporary Closure of Southbound lane.
 Approximately 08.00 – 1300
 Start: Junction at Roger Ground
 To: Junction at Graythwaite Hall
 Traffic will be able to travel north to Hawkshead from Newby Bridge & from all roads joining the C5026

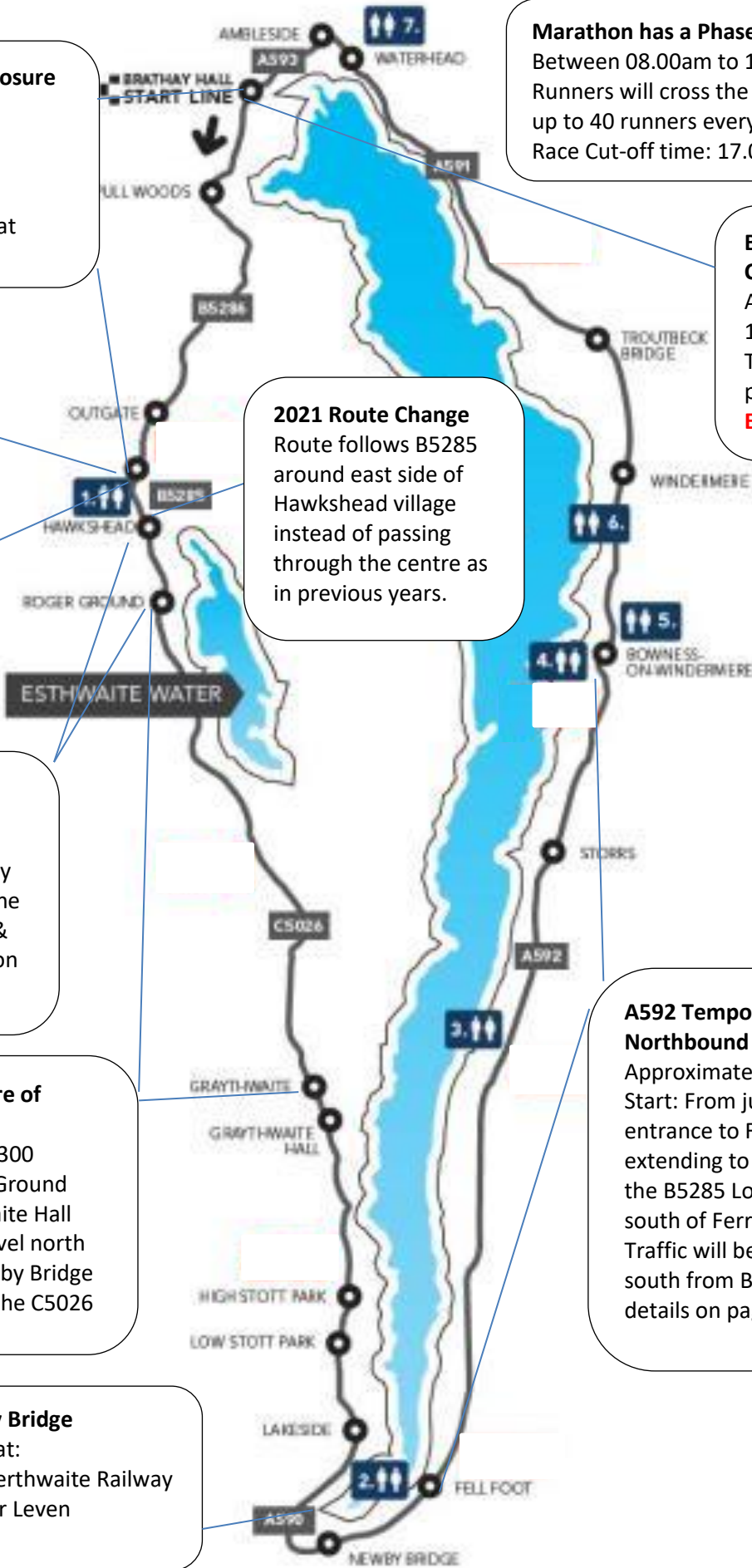

A592 Temporary Closure of Northbound lane.

 Start: From just beyond the entrance to Fell Foot Park 7 extending to the junction with the B5285 Long Tail hill just south of Ferry Nab junction.

MARATHON PHASED START 08.00 – 11.00am.

To reduce this risk of COVID-19 community transmission, the event will not have a mass start typically associated with a marathon. Runners will be spaced apart when they arrive at race HQ at Brathay Hall and throughout the race. Staggered start times have been put in place between 8-11am. Up to 40 runners will cross the start line every 5 minutes and the race has a capacity for up to 800 runners. It will start on the B5286 just outside Brathay and goes around the lake in an anti-clockwise direction before finishing on the Brathay Hall front lawn. COVID-19 control measures will be in place across the event.

Road Safety Measures around the route to protect runners and the public are outlined below:

B5286. Full Temporary Closure from 07.30 – 11.00am

Start: Clappersgate junction with A593 extending to junction of B5286/B5285 at Hawkshead Hall. The closure will be signed at all joining junctions. Vehicles will be able to access Hawkshead on the B5285 via Coniston.

B5285. OPEN with traffic controls. 08.15 – 11.15am.

Hawkshead Hall Junction of B5285/B5286 will have a Traffic Management Operative in place to manage traffic as the runners cross the junction. Traffic Control signage will be in place.

Entrance to main car/coach parking area near Tourist Information Centre will have a Traffic Management Operative in place to manage traffic as the runners cross the junction. Traffic Control signage will be in place.

C5026. OPEN UNDER CONVOY SYSTEM between the junction with the B5285 at the Bowling Green to the junction at Roger Ground. 08.00 – 13.00.

A convoy system will be in operation to enable travel in single lane form between the junctions. Traffic will be able to travel to and from Grizedale. Traffic Control signage will be in place.

C5026. Temporary Closure of southbound lane from the junction at Roger Ground to junction at Graythwaite Hall. 08.00 – 13.00. A signed DIVERSION via High Cunsey will be in place.

Traffic will be able to travel north from Newby Bridge to Hawkshead on the C5026. Traffic arriving at the Graythwaite Hall junction from High Cunsey will be able to turn right to travel to Hawkshead. Please exercise care when crossing the junction as runners will be approaching from the right on the southbound lane. Traffic Control signage will be in place.

C5026. OPEN at Newby Bridge with traffic controls. Approximately 09.30 – 14.00

Bridge over Haverthwaite Railway line. Traffic Management Operative will control single lane vehicular movements over the bridge when runners are present.

Bridge over River Leven. Temporary Traffic Signals. Approximately 09.30 – 14.00. Traffic lights will be manually operated by Traffic Management Operatives when runners are crossing the bridge over the river. Vehicular traffic entering & exiting the Swan Hotel will be managed as part of the signals operation.

A592. Temporary Closure of northbound lane. 08.00 - 15.00. Start: just north of the Fell Foot Park entrance and extending to the junction with the B5285 Long Tail Hill just south of the Ferry Nab junction. A signed DIVERSION via the A590, A5074 and B5284 Long Tail Hill will be available. Traffic will be able to travel in the southbound lane from Bowness to the A590. Traffic Control signage will be in place throughout.

B5286/A593 Junction to entrance to Brathay Hall OPEN with traffic controls. 11.00 – 16.00.

Temporary Traffic Signals will be operated to facilitate event traffic leaving the site whilst runners are approaching the Brathay Hall estate.
